The Association of Chinese Professors of Social Sciences in the United States (ACPSS) was founded in June 1995 by a group of Chinese social science and humanities professors and researchers residing in North America.

ACPSS has 22 years of fulfilling history. The association has created annual international conferences, which took place at different universities across the nation, such as State University of New York Buffalo State, University of North Florida, Harford University, Colombia University, Cornell University, Ohio State University, St, Jose State University, and California State University, Fullerton, just to name a few. The association also created its own official journal, American Review of China Studies, which has published various professors' scholarly research articles, and enjoys a collaboration with CNKI (中国知网) to publish collections of conference papers and abstracts.

ACPSS's latest conference (22nd annual conference) was successfully held at Metropolitan State University of Denver in Denver, Colorado, U.S.A. from October 14, 2016 to October 16, 2016. The conference focused on the theme of "Coping with the Challenge of Globalization" with 18 sessions of presentations. Over 80 scholars across both the U.S.A. and China, participated and presented their studies in multiple disciplines at the conference. Distinguish professor, a well-known scholar, Dr. Suisheng Zhao, from University of Denver, USA made a keynote speech on the topic of "The Obama Administration's responses to the New Model of Great Power Relations and US Reflection on the Engagement Policy toward China," which inspired a warm discussion among participants at the conference.

Now, the 23rd ACPSS International Conference is on the way. This year, the conference is to be held in High Point University, High Point, North Carolina, U.S.A. on October 20, 2017 to October 22, 2017. The theme of the conference is "Coping with the Challenge of Globalization." The conference will be featured with a keynote speech on "China's role in the reversal of globalization" 《全球化逆转中的中国角色》given by Dr. Jianxing Yu, a well-known scholar from Zhejiang University, China.
