In Memory of Xiaogang Deng



Dr. Xiaogang Deng passed away on January 25, 2021 at the age of 66 after a hard-fought battle with cancer. He was loved by many and will be deeply missed. Xiaogang and I met at Nankai University in the early 1980s when he engaged in advanced study of English in the English Department and I was a lecturer in the Sociology Department. He expressed strong interests in sociology which was also my intellectual interest and work. Our long-time friendship was initiated based on the common interest. At that time, we decided to translate an English textbook on sociological theory in collaboration with my two classmates. The translation work was successful and the translated book was published by the International Culture Press of Beijing in 1987. The book has been well received and widely used in the field of sociology since its publication. Xiaogang went to the U.S. for his graduate study right after the translation project was completed. He studied in Baylor University and the University of Oklahoma and completed his Ph.D. in Sociology at the State University of New York at Buffalo in 1994. When I was

studying for my Ph.D. at the University of New York-Albany in the early 1990s, we were reconnected and continued our friendship. Xiaogang and I had collaboratively published a number of articles and chapters in the field of criminology. We traveled together for conferences and academic exchanges in the U.S., European countries, and China. Xiaogang is a great person for his honesty, caring, sharing, and kindness. I deeply missed my close friend, a brother and express my deep condolences.


